**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rule framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Dairy India Pvt. Ltd., Chaubara Link Road, Gajraula, Tehsil-Hasanpur, District: Amroha, J.P. Nagar, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is involved in production of pasteurized milk, ghee and milk powder; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by team of officials deputed by CPCB on dated 15.04.2017; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued show cause notice 13.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit reply vide letters dated 19.06.2017, 25-06-2017, 17-07-2017, 16-08-2017 and 27.06.2017 were examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has provided OCEMS connectivity and complete registration to CPCB server.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the show cause notice dated 13.06.2017 is revoked herewith and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

- (i) The Unit shall treat their effluent to meet the prescribed effluent discharge standards.
- (ii) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server of the OCEMS.
- (iii) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognised under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of receipt of this direction.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
