**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Pasha Tanners 8/5, B-2, Asarfabad, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of Split hides to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by representatives of CPCB on 12.04.2017 and made the following observations:

- (i) The unit had valid consent to operate till December 31, 2018 under Water (Prevention & Control of pollution) Act 1974.
- (ii) The effluent parameters measured at outlet were within stipulated norms with pH 7.7 (against the norms of 6.5-9.0), Chromium 0.806 ppm (against the norms of 2 mg/l), TSS 160 ppm (against norms of 600 ppm).
- (iii) The unit had not provided online connectivity and had not registered with CPCB portal.
- (iv) The document pertaining to consent under the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and HW authorization were not submitted.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 07.06.2017 to the unit; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by CPCB on 25.07.2017 to verify the compliance status; and observed the following-

- (i) The unit and the PETP were non-operational on the day of visit.
- (ii) The unit has consent under Water Act valid up to 31.12.2018, for processing of 5 hides (Split to Finish leather) per day.
- (iii) Electromagnetic flow meter was installed at the outlet of PETP and connected to CPCB/UPPCB server.
- (iv) Log books for operation of PETP, consumption of chemical etc. were maintained by the unit.

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WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated: 07.12.2017 & 05.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made-

- (i) The unit has submitted Self Certificate and provided OCEMS connectivity of flow meter.
- (ii) The unit has consent under Water Act valid up to 31.12.2018.
- (iii) The unit has submitted undertaking in the CPCB prescribed format.
- (iv) The unit has submitted copy of the Hazardous waste authorization valid upto 20.04.2022.

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF &CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined the replies dated 07.12.2017, 05.01.2018 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following condition: -

- (i) The unit will provide effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, on weekly basis for one month.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 07.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Pasha Tanners 8/5, B-2, Asarfabad, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP)-208010 is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit will provide effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, on weekly basis for one month.
- (iii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iv) The Unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium bearing sludge disposal.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
