**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Northern Tannery, 150 Ft. Road, Jajmau, KanpurUP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of split leather to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected on 30.05.2017 by CPCB team and the following observation was made:

- (i) The unit was not complying with the prescribed standards of treated wastewater parameters for PETP with respect to pH 5.69 (against prescribed norms of 6.5-9.0) and Total Chromium 6.67 (against prescribed norms of 2.0 mg/l).

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 12.10.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for noncompliance of the prescribed PETP discharge standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated: 02.11.2017 and 18.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made-

- (i) The unit has obtained technology from CLRI for water less chrome tanning for reduction of Chrome and water consumption.
- (ii) The PETP consists of collection tank, DAF, chemical dosing tanks with mixers and settling tank.
- (iii) The unit has a CRP (Chrome Recovery Plant) and submitted photographs of the same.
- (iv) The unit has constructed separate tanks for collection of wastewater from wet blue hides piling.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 19.01.2018 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined the replies dated: 02.11.2017 and 18.01.2018 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following condition: -

- (i) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 12.10.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Northern Tannery, 150 Ft. Road, Jajmau, Kanpur is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated into the CETP.
- (iii) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (iv) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (v) The unit shall provide necessary details supporting the performance of water less chrome tanning facility within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (vi) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
