**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - Revoke reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Kings International Ltd., D-13 and C-19, (Site II), UPSIDC Industrial Area, Unnao (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected on 26.09.2017 by CPCB officials and the following observations were made:

- (i) Total Chromium of the treated effluent was 6.29 mg/l which is against stipulated norm of 2.0 mg/l.
- (ii) The unit was operating without valid consent to operate.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 08.11.2017 to the unit and directed to comply with the following directions:

- (i) The unit shall improve the PETP and its performance so as to comply with the treated effluent standards for discharge in to the CETP.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain the valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to the CPCB.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit replies vide letters dated: 29.11.2017, 20.12.2017, 05.01.2018, 10.01.2018 and 15.01.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has submitted the adequacy report of PETP, prepared by CLRI.
- (ii) The unit is improving the ETP to comply with the recommendation of CLRI as per adequacy report.
- (iii) The unit has provided copy of the letter submitted to UPPCB for renewal of consent to operate.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 19.01.2018 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined the replies dated: 29.11.2017, 20.12.2017, 05.01.2018, 10.01.2018 and 15.01.2018 and recommended for the revoke of closure direction with the following conditions: -

- (i) The unit is recommended for revocation with condition of valid CTO and HWA.
- (ii) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, from the date of resumption of operation.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 08.11.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit M/s Kings International Ltd., D-13 and C-19, (Site II), UPSIDC Industrial Area, Unnao is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
- (iii) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (iv) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (v) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
