**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, Tannery processing units are identified as one of the grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02. 1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Famous Tannery, 163/156, Laltapurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP)-208010 (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by team deputed by CPCB on 01.04.2017 and the unit was found non-operational. It was observed that the unit did not have OCEMS installed and connectivity to CPCB server.

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 22.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to remain closed and not to resume operation till installation of OCEMS and providing connectivity to CPCB/ UPPCB server; and

**WHEREAS**, unit reply vide letter dated 18.08.2017 was examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit is registered on CPCB portal.
2. The unit has provided self-certificate.
3. The unit has provided undertaking on stamp paper.

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4. The unit has provided the photographs of OCEMS (flow meter) installed in the unit.
5. Unit has provided the photocopy of electricity disconnection slip.

**AND WHEREAS**, Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 31.10.2017 examined and recommended that the unit may be allowed to resume operation and shall provide the data connectivity on CPCB server within 15 days from date of resumption of operations; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 16.11.2017 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operations and inform to CPCB regarding the resumptions of operations.
2. The unit shall provide OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server within 15 days of resumption of operations.
3. The unit shall provide treated effluent analysis report by the laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days from the resumption of operations.
4. The unit shall comply with consented conditions as issued by UPPCB.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit did not communicate to CPCB about resumption of operations, did not inform about OCEMS data connectivity, and not complied the directions dated 16.11.2017; and

**WHEREAS**, data connectivity with CPCB server was verified on 07.09.2018 and no data connectivity has been provided. The unit's OCEMS is not connected with CPCB server since last one year; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit **M/s Famous Tannery, 163/156, Laltapurwa, Jajmau, KANPUR-208010 (UP)** is hereby directed to close down its operation immediately and to comply with the following directions-

1. The unit shall provide OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server and inform to CPCB.
2. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy of the same to CPCB.
3. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations after compliance of above directions.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
