DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, Textile, Dyeing and Bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s MONDE APPARELS PVT. LTD., Shadipur, Mandhana, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile processing unit and, is engaged in bleaching and dying process of cloth; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team deputed by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 13-04-2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 05.06.2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 26.06.2017, 22.07.2017 and 27.11.2017 were examined; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 20.6.2017 and found operational, which is a violation of closure direction dated 05-06-2017 issued under section 5 Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit and for which appropriate legal action shall be taken separately; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three member committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the replies of the Unit and recommended that (i) the Unit may be allowed to resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate and (ii) the unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations and (iii) compliance verification by UPPCB within 60 days of resumption of the unit's manufacturing operations; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued revoke direction dated 16.03.2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operation after obtaining valid and revised consent to operate with discharge limit 08 KLD under Water Act and Air Act from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations
3. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

M/s MONDE APPARELS PVT. LTD., Shadipur, Mandhana, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply dated 09.04.2017 was examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has submitted modified air and water consent as granted by UPPCB after reduction in discharge capacity and thereby curtailment of production capacity.
2. The unit will submit test report of the final outlet of ETP in due course of time.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not submitted treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the Unit to **Show Cause why not the Unit should be closed down for not complying with conditional revocation dated 16.03.2018 issued under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.**

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
