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Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s MMZ Tannery (Sartaj Tanners), 104/ 90-A, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 22.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit and directed to close down all its manufacturing operations until Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) is installed and the unit gets valid consent to operate from UPPCB;

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies/documents dated 25.09.2017, 22.01.2018, 12.02.2018, 27.02.2018 and 14.09.2018 were examined and following observations were made:

- (i) The unit submitted copy of application for consent to operate, under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981.
- (ii) The unit has submitted self-certificate & undertaking in prescribed format.
- (iii) The unit has submitted the photographs of PETP components/units.
- (iv) The unit has submitted TSDF membership certificate, manifest form of hazardous waste authorization by UPPCB
- (v) The unit has submitted a copy of application for NOC from CGWA, to abstract groundwater for industrial use.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, OCEMS data Connectivity was verified at CPCB on 07.09.2018 and found connected; and

WHEREAS, Three Member Committee in meeting held on 08.10.2018 examined the replies and recommended for revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:

- (i) The unit shall submit PETP performance report annually (every year) from expert government institution.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain Consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to CPCB.
- (iii) The unit shall submit the logbook data of PETP for 06 months to the CPCB.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the direction dated 22.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit **M/s MMZ Tannery (Sartaj Tanners), 104/ 90-A, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP** is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining the valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB and permission/NOC for extraction of ground water from CGWA and submit a copy of the same to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall submit annual PETP performance report for two years from expert government institution.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain logbook of PETP and submit the logbook data of PETP for 06 months to CPCB.
- (v) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
