**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Deep Knitwear, C-19, Site- 4, Panki, Kanpur, UP (hereinafter referred to as 'the Unit'), is a textile industry engaged in cotton bleaching & dyeing activities;

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 13.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Deep Knitwear, C-19, Site- 4, Panki, Kanpur, UP) to close down all its manufacturing operations and not to restart manufacturing till it complies with the following directions and obtains permission from CPCB:

- 1) The unit shall obtain valid consent under Air and Water Acts which expired on 01.06.2016 and was extended upto 31.12.2017 by the concerned State Pollution Control Board.
- 2) The unit shall obtain authorization from CGWA and extract ground water as per quantum limit permitted.
- 3) The unit shall provide required flow meters at the bore wells, ETRP inlet & Outlet and maintain records of fresh water consumption and waste water generation. CGWA permission, as per applicable rules shall be obtained for withdrawal of ground water.
- 4) The unit shall install the required OCEMS at the ETP outlet and provide connectivity to SPCB / CPCB.
- 5) The unit shall establish a functional effluent treatment plant (ETP) so as to meet the stipulated standards for discharge of effluent.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate

Change and National Mission for Clean Ganga for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit vide letters dated 22.06.2017, 20.07.2017 and 07.09.2017 informed that it has installed flowmeter and connected with CPCB server; and

**WHEREAS**, Unit's replies dated 22.06.2017, 20.07.2017 and 07.09.2017 were examined by the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 22.11.2017 and the committee recommended the Unit to comply with the following i) Upgradation details of ETP shall be provided by the Unit with Unit wise photographs; ii) OCEMS for each parameter is required; and

**WHEREAS**, Unit has replied vide letters dated 28.12.2017, 20.03.2018, 05.04.2018 and 21.04.2018 were examined and following observations were made:

1. The Unit has applied to UPPCB for issuance of modified consent to operate with a reduced effluent discharge capacity of 8.0 KLD and domestic discharge of 1.0 KLD vide their application dated 05.12.2017.
2. The Unit has installed web-camera and flowmeter on ETP outlet and provided its connectivity to CPCB server.
3. The Unit has submitted fresh application for hazardous waste authorization.
4. The Unit has applied to CGWB for NOC of ground water abstraction.
5. The Unit has provided only the photographs of the ETP system and not provided the details of upgradation made in ETP.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Unit's replies dated 28.12.2017, 20.03.2018, 05.04.2018 and 21.04.2018 were examined by Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 25.04.2018 and recommended the following: i) The Unit will provide adequacy assessment report for ETP by any Government institution like IIT, K/HBTU etc.; and

**WHEREAS**; Unit vide letter dated 17.09.2018 submitted the adequacy report of the installed ETP in the Unit prepared by Harcourt Butler Technical University, Kanpur which indicates that ETP system is adequate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit's reply dated 17.09.2018 and ETP adequacy report were considered by the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 08.10.2018 and recommended for revoke of the closure order with the following recommendations:

1. *The Unit will submit performance audit report of ETP annually to CPCB.*
2. *The Unit will operate only after obtaining valid consent to operate from UPPCB.*
3. *Logbook data of ETP will be maintained by the Unit.*

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observation, and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit (M/s Deep Knitwears, C-19, Panki Industrial Area Site-4, Kanpur (U.P.) is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit may resume its operations only after obtaining valid consents to operate from UPPCB.
2. The Unit will inform CPCB immediately about resumption of operations.
3. The Unit will submit annual performance audit report of their ETP duly validated by a reputed Government organization for two years.
4. The Unit will monitor the notified parameters of treated effluent from ETP and maintain the logbook of ETP data including flow.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit (**M/s Deep Knitwears, C-19, Panki Industrial Area, Site-4, Kanpur, U.P.**), without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
