**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Tajammul ki Tannery, 173/ 157-C, Budhiya Ghat, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of split hides to produce finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 29.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with following directions:

- (i) The unit (M/s Tajammul Ki Tannery, 173/157 C, Budhiya Ghat, Jajmau, Kanpur) shall close down all the tannery operations with immediate effect.
- (ii) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of the direction.
- (iii) The unit shall install proper pre-treatment unit for the effluent generated before discharging it to CETP. The adequacy assessment of the PETP shall also be done post its refurbishing.
- (iv) The unit shall install and connect Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System to the CPCB server.
- (v) After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit vide letter dated 26.09.2018 submitted adequacy report for modified PETP, prepared by HBTU, Kanpur, and PETP reported adequate; and

**WHEREAS**, OCEMS data Connectivity was verified and found connected with CPCB server; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and


**WHEREAS**, Three Member Committee in meeting held on 08.10.2018 examined the replies and recommended for revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:

- (i) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report to CPCB annually.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain the valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to the CPCB.

**AND NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated 29.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit **M/s Tajammul ki Tannery, 173/ 157-C, Budhiya Ghat, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP** is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining the valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain NOC/permission from CGWA for extraction of ground water.
- (iii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iv) The unit shall submit annual PETP performance audit report to CPCB for two years.
- (v) The unit shall maintain logbook of PETP.
- (vi) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharge, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in CETP.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
