Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Classic Tanning Industries, 102/ 88, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur - 208010, UP (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 13.06.2017 under Section-5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit, to close down all its operations and not to restart till it complies with the following directions and obtain permission from CPCB:

- (i) The unit shall install the required OCEMS at the ETP outlet and provide connectivity to SPCB/ CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure that the existing ETP operates to meet the stipulated standards for discharge of effluent and maintain records of management of treated wastewater.
- (iii) Tannery process being water intensive activity, the unit shall provide flow meter to monitor water consumption.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 27.11.2017 & 15.05.2018 and email dated 08.06.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- (i) The unit has submitted Self-certificate & Affidavit in prescribed format.
- (ii) The unit submitted OCEMS user ID and password, copy of electromagnetic flow meter purchase invoice.
- (iii) The unit has submitted the photographs of PETP sub-units.
- (iv) The unit submitted copy of application for valid consent to operate.

AND WHEREAS, OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server was verified on 23.07.2018 and found connected; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, Three Member Committee in meeting held on 08.10.2018 examined the replies and recommended for revoke of closure directions with the following conditions:

- (i) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report every year prepared by recognized government institution.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain the valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to the CPCB.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the direction dated 13.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit **M/s Classic Tanning Industries, 102/ 88, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur - 208010, UP** is directed to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB and submit a copy to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall obtain NOC/permission from CGWA for extraction of ground water.
- (iii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iv) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report every year prepared by recognized government institution.
- (v) The unit shall maintain logbook of PETP.
- (vi) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
