**Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao, UP (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of raw hides to wet blue; and

**WHEREAS**, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), issued direction dated 20.02.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following-

- (i) The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Air Acts from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall provide valid consent operate (CTO) under Water Act and Air Act within 30 days from the date of receipt.
- (iv) The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharge by the unit will always comply the ETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
- (v) The unit shall submit daily analysis result of treated effluent for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of manufacturing operation.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit did not respond to CPCB directions dated 20.02.2018 and has not complied with the requirements of the direction.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao, UP to show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 20.02.2018 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
