DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 01.12.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit namely **M/s J. S. Fabrics, Lot No. 658, 659 and 660, Magarwara, Unnao, Uttar Pradesh** (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') to comply with following directions:

1. The Unit may resume the manufacturing operations and shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of manufacturing operations.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report form laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations
3. The unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notified dated 10.10.2016 under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has submitted reply dated 04.01.2018 that the unit will resume its manufacturing operations after receiving consent to operate from UPPCB and till date not informed about resumption of operations and not submitted treated effluent analysis report form laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The unit has not complied with the CPCB direction dated 01.12.2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to Show Cause why not the Unit should be closed down for not complying with**

direction dated 01.12.2017 issued under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
