Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Aftab & Company (Saukat Ki Tannery), 396, Sanjay Nagar, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P, (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is engaged in the processing of wet blue leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), issued direction dated 01.12.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions: -

- (i) The unit will inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit shall provide inclined screen with proper cleaning / feasible arrangement.
- (iii) The unit shall submit effluent test report from EPA recognized laboratory, within 30 days of resumption of operations.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain log book for Chromium bearing sludge to authorized TSDF.
- (v) UPPCB shall monitor disposal of Chromium bearing sludge to authorised TSDF site.
- (vi) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the P-ETP standards/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure regular compliance of prescribed norms in future as per CETP effluent standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

AND WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 13.12.2017 has informed about the resumption of operations from 12.12.2017. However, the unit has not submitted effluent test report in compliance with the CPCB directions dated 01.12.2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to Show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 01.12.2017 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
