Show cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Sallan Enterprises, Near Gujrat Tanners, Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is engaged in the processing of semi-finished leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), issued direction dated 21.05.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions: -

- (i) The unit shall resume operation for 30 days only and shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit shall carry out performance audit of PETP from same institute which has carried out PETP adequacy within 30 days and submit performance audit report to CPCB.
- (iii) The unit shall close its manufacturing operations after 30 days and shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations.
- (iv) The unit shall start operation only after getting valid CTO from UPPCB.
- (v) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium bearing sludge disposal.

AND WHEREAS, the unit did not respond to CPCB directions dated 21.05.2018 and not submitted any documents in compliance with the directions.


NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the Unit M/s Sallan Enterprises, Near Gujrat Tanners, Sanjay Nagar, Jajmau, Kanpur, UP to show cause, why the Unit should not be closed until the directions dated 21.05.2018 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
