Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected M/s **Micas Organics Pvt. Ltd. (Unit- II), Plot No. 3102/3101 & 3108, IV Phase, GIDC, Vapi, Gujarat** on July 13th, 2017 and observed that the unit is discharging the treated effluent to CETP. The treated effluent is exceeding the CETP inlet norms w.r.t. TDS (5114 mg/l > 2100 mg/l), and Chloride (2899 mg/l > 600 mg/l); and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the unit has not provided connectivity of flow meter to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the proper monitoring facility was not provided by the unit for incinerator & no designated storage for hazardous waste was provided by the unit; and

WHEREAS, the house keeping of the unit was not found satisfactory near sludge handling area & run off from stored sludge was found spread in the area; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, were issued by Central Pollution Control Board on August 16, 2017 to the unit to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, it has been verified by the IT division of the CPCB on October 27, 2017 that the unit has provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system to the Central Pollution Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted a notarised undertaking on 31.05.2018 that the Unit has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during verification by CPCB officials, the unit accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide self-certificate dated 30.05.2018 stated that it has stopped production with effect from 30.05.2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted the adequacy report of ETP from Faculty of Engineering Technology & Research, Surat, a GPCB recognised environmental auditor on 12.06.2018; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued Revoke directions on dated 03.07.2018 for three months with the condition that within this period the CPCB should inspect the plant and final revocation may be considered after examining the outcome of the inspection report by the committee; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara on 09.08.2018 and the unit was found complying to the issued directions.



WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 17.10.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume operation with condition to ensure uninterrupted connectivity with Central Pollution Control Board server.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of notarized undertaking submitted by the unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 **M/s Micas Organics Pvt. Ltd. (Unit- II), Plot No. 3102/3101 & 3108, IV Phase, GIDC, Vapi, Gujarat** vide letter dated August 16, 2017 is hereby revoked with condition that the unit shall ensure uninterrupted Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System connectivity with Central Pollution Control Board server.

The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.

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
