Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Globe leather finishers, 88-A, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 (UP) (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of split leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) issued direction dated 01.12.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit may resume operation and shall inform the date of resumption of operation to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of the OCEMS to the CPCB and SPCB server for treated effluent monitoring.
- (iii) The unit shall operate ETP properly to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall closed down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
- (iv) The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations to CPCB.
- (v) The unit must maintain the logbook for TSDF (treatment, storage and disposal facility) for hazardous waste.

AND WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 19.12.2017 has informed about the resumption of operations from 13.12.2017. However, the unit has not submitted treated effluent analysis report in compliance with the CPCB directions dated 01.12.2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit M/s Globe Leather Finishers, 88-A, Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 (UP) to show cause, why the Unit should not be closed until the directions dated 01.12.2017 are complied with.**

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
