**Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.**

**WHEREAS**, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Allied Leather Finishers (P) Ltd, (Unit-IV), A-38, LTP UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao UP (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is engaged in the processing of raw hides to finished leather; and

**WHEREAS**, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) issued direction dated 23.11.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions: -

1. The unit shall resume its manufacturing operation after obtaining valid consent under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act 1981 from UPPCB.
2. The implementation status of the recommendation made by CLRI in the adequacy report (Aug 2016) shall be submitted by the unit within 45 days to CPCB.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from recognized laboratory under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days after resume of operation.
4. The unit shall maintain log book of Hazardous waste disposal to TSDF.
5. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB on resumption of manufacturing operation.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit did not respond to CPCB directions dated 23.11.2017 and not complied with the requirements of directions.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit M/s Allied Leather Finishers (P) Ltd, (Unit-IV), A-38, LTP UPSIDC, Banthar, Unnao UP to Show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 23.11.2017 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
