Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pahalwan Tannery (Unit-2), '2-A' Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP), (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of raw hide to produce finished hides; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 10.09.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining the valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations and submit a copy of Consent to Operate to the CPCB.
- (iii) The unit shall submit PETP performance audit report from NPC within 45 days of start of operation.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain log book data of PETP and submit copy to CPCB every month for one year.
- (v) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

AND WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 19.09.2018 has informed that it will resume operations only after it will obtain consent to operate from UPPCB.

WHEREAS, the unit did not inform about the resumption of operations and also did not submit the copy of valid consent to operate and hence did not comply in totality with CPCB directions dated 10.09.2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to Show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 10.09.2018 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
