**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Nikhil India Cotton industries, E-52, Site-1, Unnao (hereafter referred as the unit), is a textile industry; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued directions dated 01.12.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The unit may resume the manufacturing operations and shall immediately inform to CPCB;
2. The unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality analysis report from lab recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations.

**WHEREAS**, no communication has been received from the unit till date with respect to the above mentioned directions; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the unit **M/s Nikhil India Cotton industries, E-52, Site-1, Unnao (UP)**, to Show Cause why the unit should not be closed down for not complying with directions dated 01.12.2017 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
