Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the Textile industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s U.P Dyeing & Printing Works, 68, Nauchandi Ground, Meerut, U.P.-250002 (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the processing of textile (dyeing, bleaching and printing); and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), issued revoke direction dated 23.11.2017 and directed to the unit to comply with the following-

- (i) The unit shall remain closed & shall resume manufacturing operations only after obtaining the valid consent to operate under Water Act & Air Act from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- (iv) The unit shall submit treated effluent quality report from lab recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, the unit informed that it will be starting its manufacturing operations from 09.05.2018 and not submitted treated effluent quality report from lab recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB till date and not complied with the CPCB direction dated 23.11.2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to Show Cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 23.11.2017 are complied with.

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
