**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the unit M/s Shiva Industries, C-26, Panki Industrial Estate, Site -1, Kanpur, U.P.(hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 16.03.2018 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The Unit may resume operations and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report form laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations.
3. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity OCEMS with CPCB server.
4. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has submitted reply dated 20-03-2018 that the unit has resumed its manufacturing operations and till date not submitted treated effluent analysis report form laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The unit has not complied with the CPCB direction dated 16.03.2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the Unit to **Show Cause why not the Unit should be closed down for not complying with direction dated 16.03.2018 issued under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.**

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
