Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s K.C. Tan, 101/87 B-4, Idgah Road Wajidpur, Jajmau, Kanpur (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of split leather to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), issued direction dated 12.02.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 the unit to comply with the following:


- (i) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (ii) The unit will obtain Hazardous Waste Authorization.
- (iii) The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
- (iv) The unit shall maintain log book for hazardous waste/chromium sludge disposal.
- (v) The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.
- (vi) The unit shall always ensure data transmission to CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not complied with any of the CPCB directions dated 12.02.2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 12.02.2018 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
