Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – Notice thereof

WHEREAS, the Pesticide industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, In compliance of Hon'ble NGT PB order dated 13.09.2018 in O.A. 645/2018, a joint inspection of M/s Insecticide India Ltd & CETP at Bhiwadi was carried out during 27-28.9.2018 by the officials from CPCB, Bhopal & Regional Office RSPCB, Bhiwadi; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bhopal & Regional Office RSPCB inspected the unit (M/s Insecticides India Limited, Alwar) from September 27-28, 2018 and observed the following:

1. The CTO of the Unit was expired on 31.05.2018. The industry has applied for the renewal of CTO on 30.01.2018 under the Air Act 1981 & Water Act 1974.
2. The Unit has not received permission for the abstraction of 25KLD ground water from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA).

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby issued to the Unit to show cause as to why your unit be not directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect until following directions are complied:

1. The unit shall obtain a valid CCA under Air Act, 1981 & Water Act, 1974 from Rajasthan Pollution Control Board (RSPCB).

2. The Unit (M/s Insecticides India Limited, Alwar, Rajasthan) shall obtain permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) for the abstraction of Ground water.

The time bound action plan for compliance of above directions shall be submitted to Central Pollution Control Board within 15 days of the receipt of the directions. In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board
