**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986–Notice thereof**

WHEREAS, Pharmaceutical industries are highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, TSS, COD, BOD and Flow parameters in Pharmaceutical industries; and

WHEREAS, Unit has installed online monitoring system and provided connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by official of CPCB Regional Directorates, Bhopal on September 28, 2018 under OCEMS surveillance, based on SMS alert generated during 15 July– 15 August, 2018 and observed the following:


1. The analysis results of ETP outlet w.r.t **TDS – 4704 mg/l** and **Sulphate - 2521 mg/l** are very high.
2. There is much variation in the analysis results and online monitoring values w.r.t BOD.
3. The unit has not valid Consent to Operate under the Water Act 1974 expired on 30.04.2018, applied for renewal on 28.12.2017, however, unit has not received the renewal of CTO till date.
4. The Unit has not provided plantation as per the consent condition i.e. of 33% plantation of the total area of plant premise.
5. The Unit has not obtained the Hazardous waste authorization from RSPCB, however, the unit has applied for the same on 3.10.2015.
6. During visit, 33kgs of ETP sludge was stored in HW storage room that was not as per the CPCB guideline and HW display board was not updated with latest information.
7. The unit has not obtained Consent to establish for 1250KVA DG Set, which runs on HSD (200Ltrs/hr) for 14-15 hrs monthly.
8. The unit has obtained Consent to Establish for the 3TPH boiler with Pet coke as fuel valid up to 30.09.2018. The unit has not re-apply for the CTO for the boiler as the unit has switched from pet coke to wood chips & Indonesian coal as fuel, in compliance of the MoEF notification G.S.R 96(E) dated 29.1.2018 & G.S.R 263(E) dated 22.3.2018.
9. During visit, Fugitive emission was observed near the boiler feeding & coal storage yard.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the Unit (M/s vartika chemicals and pharmaceuticals pvt. Ltd.) to show cause why the Unit should not be closed down as the Unit is not complying with respect to the above mentioned observations of the inspecting team.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.


