**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, the unit, M/s. Neman Carpet (Formerly H.A.G. Carpet Industry), C-3&4, Industrial Estate, Mirzapur-231301, UP is a textile unit; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued directions dated 04.09.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB and inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated discharge standards.
- 3) The unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP by reputed government institute within 60 days from resumption of operation.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has not replied to the above said directions till date; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the unit to Show Cause why the unit should not be closed down for not complying with directions dated 04.09.2018 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

The reply to the Show Cause Notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
