**Revoking of directions Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Jamkhandi Sugars Ltd (Distillery Division), Sy.No, s66, 72, 73, 74, 78, 79, 80 & 88, Hirepadasalagi village, Naganur-Post, Jamkhandi-Taluk, Bagalkot-Dist Karnataka (hereinafter referred to as 'the unit') was inspected by the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore, on 24-25.07.2018 based on SMS Alert/Offline Monitoring System and based on the observations, CPCB had issued a closure direction to the unit u/s 5 of the E (P) A, 1986 for the non compliances noticed during the inspection vide letter no. B-508/IPC-III/Dist/2k18-19 dated 07.09.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit vide letter dated 01.10.2018, has informed that the unit has installed continuous emission monitoring system, flow meters and cameras required for ZLD units and has provided connectivity of these systems to CPCB, and the same has been verified by the IT Division; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a three member Committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MOEF&CC for examination and recommendation of the revocation of closure directions issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee in its meeting held on 17.10.2018 reviewed the compliance made by the unit & verified the submitted supporting documents in line with the agreed

criteria and recommended the unit to submit the adequacy report of ETP/ZLD systems prior to revocation of direction; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit vide letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 has submitted the adequacy report of ETP/ZLD Systems to CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee in its meeting held on 15.11.2018 reviewed the compliance made by the unit & verified the submitted supporting documents in line with the agreed criteria and recommended that the unit may be allowed to resume its manufacturing operation with certain conditions; and; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the compliance made by the unit to the direction issued by CPCB and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **the M/s Jamkhandi Sugars Ltd (Distillery Division), Sy.No, s66, 72, 73, 74, 78, 79, 80 & 88, Hirepadasalagi village, Naganur-Post, Jamkhandi-Taluk, Bagalkot-Dist Karnataka is allowed to resume its manufacturing operations** subject to the following condition;

- a) The unit shall submit performance evaluation report of ETP/ ZLD systems along with water audit report by reputed Govt. Institute within 60 days of commencement of operations. The date of commencement of operation shall be intimated to CPCB.
- b) It shall be ensured that the installed OCEMS devices are functioning properly & continuously and that data from that device are uninterruptedly transferred to CPCB. Any failure in his regard shall be rectified at the earliest.
- c) Unit shall ensure periodic calibration and O&M of the analyzers as per Standard Operating Procedure/recommendations of the supplier.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the Unit, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice

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
