Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. Anil Steel (P) Ltd., Unit-III, Sonipat (herein after referred as the Unit) on June 25, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit was operational on the day of inspection and observed the following:

1. The ETP of the Unit was not operational during visit.
2. The Unit has not provided dedicated area for storage of Hazardous Waste.
3. The Unit has not taken any safety measures during the process of Galvanization as it is carried out in open bath.

WHEREAS, a closure direction u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, dated October 08, 2018 with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall provide proper space for storage of Hazardous waste as per Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
3. The Unit shall adopt safety measures during galvanization process according to the consent condition.
4. The Unit shall not resume the plant operation till it ensures operation of Effluent Treatment Plant so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge and permission is obtained from the CPCB.

WHEREAS, The Unit informed vide letter dated October 22, 2018 that they have complied with all the CPCB directions dated October 08, 2018 and they have replaced the defective parts of ETP; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated October 22, 2018 has submitted notarized affidavit, self-certificate dated 18.12.2018 and third party analysis report from M/s Arihant Analytical Laboratory (NABL accredited Laboratory) for the treated effluent; and


WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 06.12.2018 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that the Unit may be allowed to resume its operations with a condition that the unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by any reputed Government Institution within 60 days of start of operation.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of observed compliance by the unit, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 M/s. Anil Steel (P) Ltd., Unit-III, Sonipat vide letter dated October 08, 2018 is hereby revoked with a condition that the unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system by analysis of treated effluent by any reputed Government Institution within 60 days of start of operation.

The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken
