DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP (hereafter referred as Unit), it is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 12.03.2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall resume operation after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 45 days of resumption of operations
3. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.
4. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.


AND WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 23.03.2018 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has informed that the unit will resume its manufacturing operations after obtaining consent to operate under Water and Air Acts from UPPCB.
2. The unit will submit treated effluent analysis report within time limit.
3. The unit will ensure that the OCEMS connectivity will continued with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not complied with the CPCB direction dated 12.03.2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is hereby served to the Unit **M/s. Muskan Dyeing, Nai Basti, Naugawan Sadat, Amroha- 244251 UP** to **Show Cause why not the Unit should be closed down for not complying with direction dated 12.03.2018 issued under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.**

The reply to the show cause notice shall be submitted to this office within 15 days from the date of this notice failing which suitable action as deemed fit under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be initiated.
