**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/S Shivam Textiles (New Name: Singh Textiles), J-49, Industrial Area, Panki, Site-3, Kanpur, UP (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the processing of textile (dyeing, bleaching and printing); and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 16.03.2018 under section Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions-

- 1) The unit may resume manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act from UPPCB for curtailed capacity at less than <10KLD.
- 2) The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the date of resumption of operations.
- 3) The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4) The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report, to CPCB within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation, from a laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 5) The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has not submitted any compliance status of CPCB direction dated 16.03.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, a show cause notice was issued to the Unit on 16.11.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for failing to comply with CPCB directions dated 16.03.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit has replied to the show cause notice vide their letter dated 07.12.2018 which was examined and following is observed:

1. The Unit has submitted copy of Consent to operate issued by UPPCB under Water and Air Act dated 07.08.2018 with validity upto 31.12.2019 for a discharge capacity of 8.0 KLD of industrial treated effluent.
2. The Unit has informed that they have resumed the process activities after grant of Air & Water consent from the UPPCB (dated 07.08.2018) for the reduced capacity of discharge & simultaneous curtailment in the production activity.
3. The Unit submitted that *Unit is operating the installed ETP smoothly for efficient discharge results.*
4. The Unit has submitted a copy of test report tested by Ecomen Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Lucknow samples from ETP outlet with sampling date of 07.12.2018 and date of report as 13.12.2018 by email on 14.12.2018.
5. The Unit has provided the details of online connectivity vis. Username and password with URL, and connectivity of flowmeter can be seen on CPCB portal.

**AND NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above and exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued to the Unit **M/S Shivam Textiles (New Name: Singh Textiles), J-49, Industrial Area, Panki, Site-3, Kanpur, UP:**

1. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
2. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the Unit, without giving and further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
