DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, Tannery processing units are identified as one of the grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02. 1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Pasha Tanners, 8/5 B-2, Asharfabad, Jajmau, KANPUR-208010 (UP) (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a tannery engaged in processing of split hides to produce finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by team deputed by CPCB on 12.04.2017; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued direction dated 07.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down the operations till obtains consent to operate under Air Act, 1981, provides online connectivity and registers with CCB portal, obtains Authorization under HWM; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected again by team deputed by CPCB on 25.07.2017 to verify the compliance of the closure direction dated 07.06.2017 and the unit was found non-operational; and

WHEREAS, unit reply vide letter dated 07.12.2017, 11.12.2017 and 05.01.2018 were examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit has submitted Self-certificate and provided OCEMS connectivity with CPCB server.
2. The unit has consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 valid up to 31.12.2018.
3. The unit has submitted Undertaking in the CPCB prescribed format.
4. The unit has submitted copy of Hazardous Waste Authorization valid up to 20.04.2022.

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AND WHEREAS, Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined and recommended that the unit may be allowed to resume operation; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 01.02.2018 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
2. The unit shall submit effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, on weekly basis for one month.
3. The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
4. The unit shall maintain logbook for hazardous waste/ Chromium bearing sludge disposal.

AND WHEREAS, the unit did not communicate to CPCB about resumption of operations and not complied the directions dated 01.02.2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show-cause dated 14.11.2018 to the unit for non-compliance with respect to the directions dated 01.02.2018;

WHEREAS, the unit did not reply/ respond to CPCB regarding the directions dated 01.02.2018 and Show-cause dated 14.11.2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit **M/s Pasha Tanners, 8/5 B-2, Asharfabad, Jajmau, KANPUR-208010 (UP)** is hereby directed to close down its operation immediately and to comply with the following directions-

1. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations after compliance of above directions.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
