DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, Tannery processing units are identified as one of the grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02. 1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, BANTHAR, Distt. Unnao (UP) (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to wet blue; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by team deputed by CPCB on 12.04.2017 and the unit was found closed; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued direction dated 28.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to remain closed till it has adequate arrangements for treating effluents, installs & connects online monitoring system and obtains valid consent; and

WHEREAS, unit reply vide letter dated 15.11.2017, 06.12.2017, 18.12.2017 and 27.12.2017 were examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit has installed OCEMS (online flow meter) and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
2. The unit has provided Self-certificate (in original).
3. The unit has provided application copy of consent to operate under Water Act, 1974.
4. The unit has installed filter press and submitted photographs of the same.
5. The unit has provided copy of Authorization under HWM having validity up to 24.10.2018.

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AND WHEREAS, Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 19.01.2018 examined and recommended that the unit may be allowed to resume operation; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 20.02.2018 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act and Air Act from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
3. The unit shall provide valid consent to operate (CTO) under Water Act and Air Act within 30 days from the date of receipt.
4. The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the unit will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB/ inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.
5. The unit shall submit analysis result of the treated effluent on daily basis for one month from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, within 45 days from the date of resumption of operation.

AND WHEREAS, the unit did not communicate to CPCB about resumption of operations and not complied the directions dated 20.02.2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show-cause dated 05.11.2018 to the unit for non-compliance with respect to the directions dated 20.02.2018;

WHEREAS, the unit did not reply/ respond to CPCB regarding the directions dated 20.02.2018 and Show-cause dated 05.11.2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit **M/s Alig Tannery, A-25, LTP, UPSIDC, BANTHAR, Distt. Unnao (UP)** is hereby directed to close down its operation immediately and to comply with the following directions-

1. The unit shall obtain Hazardous Waste Authorization.
2. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate from UPPCB and submit a copy of the same to CPCB.
3. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of operations after compliance of above directions.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


