**Show cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.**

**WHEREAS**, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Tayyaba International, 1 D, 14-A-1 Gajjapurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP), (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is a tannery engaged in the processing of split leather to produce finish leather; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued directions dated 24.09.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following:

- (i) The unit shall resume operation, for 60 days, only after obtaining the valid consent from UPPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iii) The unit shall close down its operation on expiry of 60 days and shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operations.
- (iv) The unit shall submit Treated Effluent Analysis report on weekly basis for one month.
- (v) The unit shall ensure uninterrupted data transmission to CPCB server.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has not complied with any of the CPCB directions dated 24.09.2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **notice is hereby served to the Unit to Show cause, why the Unit should not be closed** until the directions dated 24.09.2018 are complied with.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which appropriate action will be taken against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
