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**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit M/s Balaji Industries, 1582, Near Gokul Baba Power House, Magarwara, Unnao, U.P. (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile unit; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 19.02.2018 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The Unit may resume manufacturing operations with immediate effect.
2. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB regarding the resumption of operations.
3. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
4. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report by the Laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of the unit.
5. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity OCEMS with CPCB server.
6. The unit shall obtain permission form CGWA for extraction of groundwater.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has not submitted any reply of the above said directions to CPCB till date; and

**WHEREAS**, a show cause notice was issued to the Unit on 16.11.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for failing to comply with CPCB directions dated 19.02.2018; and


**WHEREAS**, the Unit has replied to the show cause notice vide their letter dated 07.12.2018 which was examined and following is observed:

1. Unit has informed that it has resumed the process activities after grant of consent under Air & Water Act from UPPCB issued on 23.05.2018, which has validity upto 31.12.2019.
2. As per consent the Unit has a consent to discharge 2.0 KLD of industrial effluent through ETP.
3. The Unit has submitted that they are operating the installed ETP smoothly for efficient discharge results.
4. The Unit has submitted test report of treated effluent from ETP outlet dated 14.07.2018 issued by M/s Ecomen Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Lucknow.
5. Unit has provided the details of online connectivity vis. Username and password with URL and connectivity of flowmeter seen on CPCB portal as on 31.12.2018.
6. Unit has provided a copy of application submitted on 08.09.2018 for NOC to CGWA for extraction of ground water.

**AND NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above and exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued to the Unit **M/S M/s Balaji Industries, 1582, Near Gokul Baba Power House, Magarwara, Unnao, U.P.** for complying:

1. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
2. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity of OCEMS system installed at the outlet of ETP with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the Unit, without giving and further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
