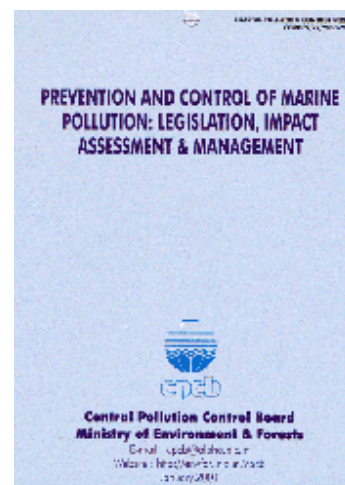


Prevention and Control of Marine Pollution : Legislation, Impact Assessment & Management
