Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS on the basis of SMS alerts generated by online monitoring system at the unit during a period of January 15, 2018 to February 15, 2018, a team of officers from the Regional Directorate, Central Pollution Control Board, Vadodara visited the unit M/S Deepak Fertilizers & Petrochemicals Corporation Ltd., K-1 to K-8, MIDC Industrial Area, Taloja, Dist- Raigad, Maharashtra on April 06, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS it was observed during the inspection that online continuous emission monitoring system installed by the unit does not carry out continuous analysis of the parameters; and

WHEREAS as per IT Division, CPCB report dated April 23, 2018 it was observed that the unit has not installed online continuous effluent monitoring system for Fluoride parameter at ETP-1 outlet and Fluoride & Ammonical Nitrogen parameters are not provided at the ETP-2 outlet ; and

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WHEREAS as per IT Division, CPCB report dated April 23, 2018 it was observed that the unit has not installed online continuous emission monitoring system for PM, Ammonia and Fluoride parameters at the stacks of the unit; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, were issued by Central Pollution Control Board on May 07, 2018 to the unit to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has informed vide Self certificate dated December 25, 2018 that the unit has not stopped its manufacturing operations in compliance to the direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted an undertaking of December 24, 2018 that it has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during verification by CPCB officials, the Unit will accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and

WHEREAS, it has been verified by the IT division of the CPCB on December 19, 2018 that the unit has provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system to the Central Pollution Control Board; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office order dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MoEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB;

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 08.01.2019 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended that closure direction may be revoked with condition that the unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring System data with Central Pollution Control Board server.; and


WHEREAS the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of notarized undertaking submitted by the unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/S Deepak Fertilizers & Petrochemicals Corporation Ltd., K-1 to K-8, MIDC Industrial Area, Taloja, Dist- Raigad, Maharashtra** vide letter dated May 07, 2018 is hereby revoked with condition that the unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring System data with Central Pollution Control Board server.


Since the unit did not close its operations despite closure directions issued by CPCB which is noncompliance for which the directions to impose penalty for Environmental Compensation shall be issued separately.

The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
