**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Jet Knitwears Ltd., 57-A Dada Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a textile industry; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued direction dated 29.11.2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall resume the manufacturing operations and inform immediately to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazetted notified dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
3. The unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report from laboratory recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of operations.

**AND WHEREAS**, the unit has submitted reply dated 11.10.2018, that the unit closed down the bleaching/processing work and vacant premises is used for storing, packing, re-packing and dispatch of finished goods; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued to the unit:

1. The unit shall get the consent to operate from UPPCB immediately amended and submit a copy of the same to CPCB.
2. The unit shall not restart its manufacturing operations without prior consent from UPPCB.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
