Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Prateek Arts, (hereafter referred as the Unit), is a textile industry located at D3, D4, Industrial Estate, Thandhi Sadak, Farrukhabad; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 11th December, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit as follows:

- 1) The unit shall close down all manufacturing operations immediately.
- 2) The unit shall install Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and provide connectivity with the CPCB server.
- 3) The unit shall upgrade ETP system so as to comply with the notified effluent discharge standards and shall submit the ETP adequacy report prepared by reputed institute to CPCB.
- 4) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately.
- 5) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 9th April, 2018, 24th July, 2018, 10th October, 2018 and 19th December, 2018 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has submitted a self-certificate regarding stopping of industrial operations.
- 2) The unit has installed flow meter and web camera at the outlet of ETP and provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- 3) The unit has submitted adequacy report of their ETP prepared by HBTU, Kanpur.

WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF & CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 24th December, 2018 examined the replies dated 9th April, 2018, 24th July, 2018, 10th October, 2018 and 19th December, 2018 and recommended that:

- 1) The unit shall submit performance assessment report of the ETP within 60 days.
- 2) The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Prateek Arts, D3, D4, Industrial Estate, Thandhi Sadak, Farrukhabad** is directed to comply with the following directions:


- 1) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent form and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall submit performance assessment report of the ETP by a reputed government institute within 60 days of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
