**Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.**

**WHEREAS**, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Pilakhua Water Proofing Company, Jindal Nagar, Hapur (hereafter referred as the unit) is a textile industry; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued directions dated 19.03.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent with reduced capacity from UPPCB and shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
2. The unit shall submit a treated effluent analysis report from Environmental laboratory recognized by Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 45 days of resuming operation.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued Show Cause Notice dated 14.11.2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for not submitting any reply of directions dated 19.03.2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit vide its letter dated 20.11.2018 has submitted consent to operate from UPPCB valid upto 29.08.2019 and treated effluent analysis report in compliance of CPCB directions dated 19.03.2018; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve compliance of stipulated standards.
2. The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
