Sub: Directions (Notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Chlor-alkali industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Unit (M/s Grasim Industries Ltd, Chemical Division, Rehla, Garhwa Road, Rehla- 822124, Palamu, Jharkhand) was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Kolkata on September 13 & 14, 2018 to investigate the complaint received from Sh. Vishnu Dayal Ram, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Lok Sabha and following observations were made by the inspection team:

1. The unit discharges RO reject to the drain which meets the Koel River.
2. The unit has not provided satisfactory information regarding fly ash disposal.
3. The unit has stored coal and salt in open.
4. The unit has not provided proper source emission monitoring facilities at HCl stacks A & B.


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, based on available facts and observations, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, you are directed to show cause as to why all manufacturing / production activities of your unit should not be closed until the above stated observed shortcomings are complied with.


