Sub: Show Cause Notice Under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has developed a protocol for selection of industries for inspection based on SMS alerts generated from OCEMS due to non-compliance of effluent discharge norms and non-connectivity of OCEMS; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s K K Enterprises, Plot No. 7B/5, MIE Part-B, Bahadurgarh, Haryana was selected for inspection in view of SMS alerts generated from OCEMS [Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring Systems] due to non-compliance of effluent discharge norms; and

WHEREAS, inspection of M/s K K Enterprises, Plot No. 7B/5, MIE Part-B, Bahadurgarh, Haryana (hereafter referred as "Unit") was conducted by a team of officers from CPCB Regional Directorate Lucknow on July 21, 2018 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, it was observed during inspection that the unit has full-fledged infrastructure for processing wet blue skins of small animals (goats / sheeps) to finished leather with reported installed capacity of 1000 skins/day. During inspection, the unit was in operation. Other observations requiring attention of Regulating Authority were as follows:

1. Source of water is bore-well which is not fitted with electro-magnetic flow meter. Further, the unit has not obtained NOC from CGWA for extraction of ground water.
2. Samples were collected from the equalization tank, aeration tank, outlet of secondary tube-settler and final outlet. It is observed from the analysis results that the operation of ETP is not upto mark. It is evident from the following :
 - a. BOD values at the final outlet is 82 mg/l which is not meeting with the stipulated norms of 30 mg/l.
 - b. The values of TDS is as high as 7199 mg/l .
 - c. Active Biomass i.e. MLSS in the aeration tank is very low and to the tune of 2065 mg/l only and it is indicating poor operation/unstabilization of ETP.
3. The unit has not provided separate energy meter for the operation of ETP. Log book is also not maintained.
4. The unit has been granted Authorization under the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules , 2016 for handling of 3 kg/month of chrome bearing residues / sludge. But the unit is generating approx. 400 kg per month of ETP Sludge, which is not in line with the Authorization granted by Haryana State Pollution Control Board.
5. Overall HW Management of the unit is very poor and even proper storage facilities are not provided. Also, the unit has not maintained any log book on HW generation and disposal.
6. The unit has one DG set (Capacity 125 KVA), which is not equipped with stack of adequate height.

WHEREAS, the above compliance status had indicated violation of notified norms. Accordingly, in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/s K K Enterprises, Plot No. 7B/5, MIE Part-B, Bahadurgarh, Haryana** had been directed on 09.08.2018 to close down its manufacturing activities with immediate effect. The Unit was further directed for the following:

1. The Unit shall submit a time-targeted action plan within 15 days for rectification of short comings as described above.
2. The unit shall rectify the shortcomings as per time targeted action plan.
3. The Unit shall not re-start its manufacturing activities unless required corrective measures are taken and without written permission from CPCB.
4. The Unit shall ensure compliance of these directions failing which action shall be taken against the Unit, without giving any further opportunity, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the Unit vide its letter received in CPCB on 12.09.2018 had informed about the steps taken to comply with the directions dtd. 09.08.2018 issued by CPCB by way of improving the pollution control practices and requested for revocation of the Closure Directions. The industry had submitted following documents as documentary evidences in support of measures taken :

- a. An Affidavit dated 12.09.2018 on stamp paper duly notarised to the effect that compliance of the CPCB directions has been done.
- b. Copies of Combined Consent under the Water (P&C of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (P&C of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under the H&OW (M&TBM) Rules, 2016 as issued by Haryana SPCB . All these Consents / Authorization are valid upto 30.09.2021.
- c. Copy of the ' ETP Up-gradation cum Adequacy Report ' prepared by a Private Consultant .
- d. Photographs on measures undertaken by the industry to improve pollution control practices so as to comply with CPCB Directions.

WHEREAS, the case of revocation of the closure directions issued to the unit was examined by the 'Committee' constituted by CPCB during its meeting convened on Sept. 27, 2018 and the Committee had recommended for revocation of Closure Directions subject to certain conditions;

WHEREAS, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure directions issued to the Unit namely : **M/s K K Enterprises, Plot No. 7B/5, MIE Part-B, Bahadurgarh, Haryana** were revoked on Oct. 11, 2018 and the unit was permitted to restart the manufacturing operations , subject to following conditions :

- (i) The Unit shall engage some government agency like CLRI/IIT/NPC/ Govt. Engg. College for ETP performance evaluation and report be submitted within 60 days to CPCB.
- (ii) The unit shall submit monthly log-book data of ETP for one month.
- (iii) The unit shall get compliance verification from Haryana SPCB & submit the report to CPCB within 3 months.
- (iv) The Unit shall ensure all time compliance with prescribed discharge norms and proper functioning of OCEMS.
- (v) The unit shall run only with valid Consent from Haryana State Pollution Control Board under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 , Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- (vi) In case of failure of the Unit to comply with directions, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken against the Unit.


WHEREAS, the unit had not submitted any Action taken Report and Compliance Report so far in respect of conditions of the Revocation Directions which proves that the Unit has failed to comply the conditions as mentioned from Sr. No. i to iv of the revocation directions issued by CPCB on 11.10.2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above non-compliance and in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, **M/s K K Enterprises, Plot No. 7B/5, MIE Part-B, Bahadurgarh, Haryana** is hereby directed to show cause as to why the unit should not be closed down with immediate effect. The Unit is further directed for the following:

1. The Unit shall immediately initiate steps for compliance of the conditions as mentioned at Sr. No. i to iv of the revocation order dtd. 11.10.2018 and all the tasks be completed within 15 days.
2. The industry shall pay an Environmental Compensation of Rs. 10,60,000/- only [Rs. Ten Lacs , Sixty Thousand only] @ Rs 10,000/- per day wef 11.10.2018 i.e. the date of revocation of the closure order till 25.01.2019, as per Environmental Compensation Policy framed in compliance of NGT order dtd .31.08.2018 in OA no. 593/2017.

The Unit shall submit its reply within 15 days from the date of receipt of this ' Show Cause Notice ' and also the Action Taken Report with documentary evidences to CPCB and Haryana State Pollution Control Board.

The Unit shall ensure compliance of these directions failing which action shall be taken against the Unit, without giving any further opportunity, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


