Compliance Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which has been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violation of standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s National Handloom Industries, Mohkampur Industrial Area, Phase-2, Delhi Road, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred as the unit) is a textile industry; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 26.12.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The Unit shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of the manufacturing operations;
2. The Unit shall submit treated effluent analysis report by the EPA recognized laboratory within 30 days from the resuming operation. and
3. The Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

WHEREAS, Show Cause notice dated 05.11.2018 was issued to the unit for not complying with directions dated 29.11.2017 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide its letters dated 22.11.2018 and 26.12.2018 has submitted treated effluent analysis report in compliance of CPCB directions dated 26.12.2017; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve compliance of stipulated standards.

2. The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit, **M/s National Handloom Industries, Mohkampur Industrial Area, Phase-2, Delhi Road, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh** without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
