Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Globe Industries, Plot no. 37-B, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 (UP) (here in after referred as the Unit), is a tannery engaged in manufacturing of Leather Board from unwanted cutting & waste generated from Leather dust and Leather goods units; and

WHEREAS, CBCB issued direction dated 04.07.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed till it has adequate arrangements for treating effluent, installs and connects online effluent monitoring system and possesses valid consent.
2. The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of manufacturing operation.

AND WHEREAS, OCEMS data Connectivity was verified by CPCB, IT- Division dated 27.07.2017 and found connected with CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 27.07.2017 and 14.04.2018 submitted documentary evidence of purchase of online monitoring system, user name and password of OCEMS registration, self-certificate and undertaking; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three Member Committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revoke of the closure direction.

WHEREAS, Three-member committee in its meeting held on 18.05.2018 examined the documents and recommended for revoke of closure direction with the following conditions:

1. The unit is recommended for revocation for 60 days only after obtaining consent from SPCB.
2. The unit will submit performance audit report within this period from reputed government institution.
3. The report will be put up before committee.
4. Unit will operate only after obtaining consent from SPCB.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued direction dated 04.06.2018, under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed and shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
3. The unit shall close down its operation on expiry of 60 days.
4. The unit shall submit performance audit report within this period from reputed government institution.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued Show Cause Notice direction dated 08.11.2018, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the CPCB direction dated 04.06.2018; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letter dated 21.11.2018 and 06.01.2019 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit submitted copy of Consent to Operate, under Water Act (1974) valid from 19.09.2018 to 18.11.2018
2. The unit informed about resumption of operations from 29.10.2018, after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act (1974)
3. The unit submitted copy of Performance Audit Report of Primary Effluent Treatment Plant.
4. The unit submitted copy of Application for renewal of Consent to Operate, under Water Act (1974) and Air Act (1981) dated 16.12.2018.

AND WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee for Revoke in meeting held on 16.01.2019 examined the unit replies vide letters dated 21.11.2018 and 06.01.2019 and recommended for revocation in view of PETP Performance audit report.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, CPCB directions dated 04.07.2017, 04.06.2018 and Show Cause Notice dated 08.11.2018 are revoked and **M/s Globe Industries, Plot no. 37-B, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 (UP)**, is directed to comply with the following:

1. The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent to operate from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall inform immediately to CPCB, on resumption of manufacturing operations.
3. The unit shall take necessary action to ensure that PETP treated effluent discharged, will always comply the PETP standards prescribed by UPPCB / inlet to CETP standards and ensure that PETP effluent is treated in the CETP.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, the CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
