Compliance Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which has been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violation of standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Kanta Polytex (India) Pvt. Ltd., Plot no. 18, Sector-8, Ved Vyas Puri Ind. Area, Putha (Rithani), Meerut-250103, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred as the unit) is a textile industry; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 30.11.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate from SPCB before resuming operation and shall inform the date of resumption of operation to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of the OCEMS to the CPCB and SPCB server for treated effluent monitoring.
3. The unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
4. The unit shall submit analysis report of treated effluent from laboratory recognized under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations to CPCB.

AND WHEREAS, Show Cause notice dated 05.11.2018 was issued to the unit for not complying with directions dated 30.11.2017 under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide its letters dated 17.11.2018 and emails dated 31.12.2018 and 05.01.2019 were examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit has submitted that it had resumed operation from 15.01.2018.

2. The unit has submitted water and air consents valid upto 31.12.2018.
3. The unit has submitted that it has installed OCEMS and is maintaining uninterrupted connectivity.
4. The unit has submitted that its Effluent Treatment Plant is operational and treated effluent is discharged as per discharge norms.
5. The unit has submitted treated effluent analysis report which shows compliance with stipulated standards.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve compliance of stipulated standards.
3. The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit, **M/s Kanta Polytex (India) Pvt. Ltd., Plot no. 18, Sector-8, Ved Vyas Puri Ind. Area, Putha (Rithani), Meerut-250103** without giving any further notice.
