Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) of M/s Kawman Pharma, Tamilnadu (herein after referred to as the Unit) generated 225 alerts for parameters pH during 15 September- 15 October, 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by official of CPCB Regional Directorates, Bangalore on December 22, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system and observed the following:

1. The Multiple Effect Evaporator (MEE) and Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) were not in operation during inspection.
2. The analysis results of sample collected from treated effluent storage tank is exceeding the prescribed limits w.r.t BOD - (550 mg/l > 100 mg/l) and COD (743 mg/l > 250 mg/l).

WHEREAS, the online data connectivity has been verified from IT division and it was observed by the IT division dated February 08, 2019 that the camera feed for camera installed at ETP outlet was not available at the time of data verification; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Kawman Pharma, Tamilnadu is directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation till the following directions are compiled:

1. The Unit shall properly operate ETP on continuous basis so as to achieve the discharge standards.

2. The Unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of OCEMS data with CPCB server.
3. The Unit shall obtain written permission from the CPCB for resuming the plant operations.


In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board


