**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-regarding**

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System OCEMS of the Unit M/s. Mylan laboratories Ltd., Unit-8, Andhra Pradesh (herein after referred to as the Unit) generated 120 alerts for parameter pH during 15 June-15 July 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on August 28, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:

1. The source emission monitoring was carried out for PM and the results indicate PM concentration ( $154 \text{ mg/Nm}^3 > 100 \text{ mg/Nm}^3$ ) exceeded 1.5 time than the standard prescribed by APPCB.
2. The Hazardous waste disposal details of July 2018 indicate that the unit has disposed 107 tons of spent solvent (coloured) & 211 tons of Stripper VOCs against the authorization capacity of 80 tons & 100 tons respectively.

WHEREAS, on the basis of observations of inspecting team from CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore during inspection on August 28, 2018, a direction (Show cause notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 was issued to the Unit vide dated October 09, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit submitted a reply vide letter dated November 05, 2018 that the Unit has complied with all the direction dated October 09, 2018 issued by CPCB, and requested to revoke the direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has also submitted stack emission monitoring reports of boiler stack from MoEF&CC recognized lab M/s Lawn Enviro Associates, copy of continuous online monitoring data for Particulate Matter and copy of amended consent & authorization dated October 12, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the RD, Bangalore on February 05, 2019 to assess the compliance status of the Unit and the Unit was found complying w.r.t. show cause notice issued dated October 09, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of compliance with relevant direction under reference, the direction (show cause notice) issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Mylan laboratories Ltd., Unit-8, Andhra Pradesh) vide letter dated October 09, 2018 is hereby revoked. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
