Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-regarding

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, it was observed by the IT division of the CPCB that the Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) of M/s. Polypeptide Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Maharashtra (herein after referred to as the Unit) generated alerts for parameters BOD & TSS during 15 June-15 July 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Vadodara on August 20, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observed as following:

1. The treated effluent analysis results show that the parameter pH (9.56 > 6.5-8.5) exceeds the MPCB standards.
2. The OCEMS installed by the Unit was non-operational on the day of visit.

WHEREAS, on the basis of observations of inspecting team from CPCB Regional Directorate, Vadodara during inspection on August 20, 2018, a direction (Show cause notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 was issued to the Unit vide dated October 23, 2018; and


WHEREAS, the Unit submitted a reply vide letter received on November 08, 2018 that the Unit has complied with all the directions dated October 23, 2018 issued by CPCB, and requested to revoke the direction; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was again inspected by a team of official(s) from the RD, Vadodara on January 18, 2019 to assess the compliance status of the Unit and the Unit was found complying w.r.t. show cause notice issued dated October 23, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


