Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, the Oil Refineries industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Unit has provided the connectivity of the online monitoring system of Stacks and for Effluent data to the CPCB as per detail registered by the unit on Aug 6, 2015 and CPCB IT Division report dated March 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued letter to SPCBs/PCCs dated May 01, 2018 for compliance verification with respect to environmental discharge standards with list of selected industries from chemical sector; and

WHEREAS, Odisha State Pollution Control Board submitted the report vide letter dated August 04, 2018, observations from the report are as following:

1. The treated effluent from unit was not meeting the norms during the monitoring carried out on 19.06.2018, 29.03.2018, 31.01.2018, 31.08.2017, 17.07.2017.w.r.t **TSS 28, 34, 42, 36, 60 > 20 mg/l** and **BOD 20, 16, 18 > 15 mg/l** respectively prescribed by Odisha State Pollution Control Board.
2. During the monitoring on July 05, 2018 unit is exceeding the norms w.r.t **TSS 29.2, 27.4, 29.6 > 20 mg/l** and **BOD 22, 17, 21 > 15 mg/l** of all three samples respectively.

WHEREAS, Unit has not provided online data connectivity to CPCB for Flow parameter, as per status of CPCB, OCEMS central server connectivity checked on August 16, 2018, but as per report of Odisha SPCB unit has provided connectivity for the same; and

WHEREAS, based on above stated observations, Directions (notice) under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, was issued to M/s IOCL Paradeep Refinery, Odisha on August 21, 2018 to show cause as to why your unit not be directed to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, response received from unit against show cause notice through e-mail on September 28, 2018 vide letter dated September 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB requested to SPCB vide letter dated October 03, 2018 to re-inspect the unit for verification of compliance of show cause notice; and

M/s IOCL Paradeep Refinery, Odisha

WHEREAS, Odisha SPCB has submitted the re-inspection report through e-mail on Jan 16, 2019 and observed that unit is meeting the norms w.r.t TSS 16, 14, 15 < 20 mg/l and BOD 12, 14, 13 < 15 mg/l as per analysis report dated Jan 03, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Unit has provided online data connectivity to CPCB server for online monitoring of source emission (PM, CO, NO_x & SO_x parameters) and effluent (pH, BOD, COD, TSS, Flow parameter) as per IT Division report dated February 08, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, show cause notice issued to M/s IOCL Paradeep Refinery, Odisha, vide letter dated August 21, 2018, is hereby revoked with following condition:

1. Unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
