**DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, Textile and dyeing unit are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

**WHEREAS**, inspection of M/s. Maharaja Bleaching Works, D-76, Panki, Site-IV, Kanpur, UP (hereafter referred as 'Unit') was conducted on 15.04.2017 by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms and following are the findings of the inspection:

1. The unit is not having valid authorization under Hazardous & Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
2. Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) is not installed by the Unit.
3. As per the effluent analysis results of ETP outlet, the concentration of following parameters exceeding the prescribed limits as compared to the standards for the discharge of effluent for textile industry; Total Suspended Solids - 320 mg/l as against norm of 100 mg/l; BOD - 85 mg/l as against norm of 30 mg/l; Sulphide- 5 mg/l as against norm of 1mg/l; Oil & Grease - 72 mg/ as against norm of 10mg/l; COD -288 mg/l as against norm of 250 mg/l.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued a closure direction dated 13.06.2017 to the Unit under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to close down operations till (i) the Unit achieved the compliance to the notified effluent discharge standards under the Environment (Protection) Rule, 1986 (ii) the Unit installed the Continuous Online Monitoring System and provide its connectivity to the CPCB / UPPCB server (iii) the Unit obtains valid Authorization under the Hazardous & other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016.

**WHEREAS**, the unit's replies vide letters dated 11.07.2017, 09.08.2017, 12.09.2017, 12.12.2017, 19.12.2017 and 02.02.2018 were examined and following observations are made:

1. The Unit has submitted copy of application for consent to operate under Water Act made to UPPCB for modified industrial discharge capacity 8.0KLD;
2. The Unit has informed that it has installed flow meter and web camera for treated effluent quantity monitoring;
3. The Unit has submitted details (size and components) of their ETP plant vide letter dated 19.12.2017 & Email dated 02.02.2018 along with photographs of ETP components as i) Equalization Tank; ii) Chemical Dosing Tank; iii) Settling Tank-1; iv) Settling Tank-2;

v) Sludge drying beds (2 nos.); vi) ETP is provided with 2 nos. of stirring assembly and blower assembly

4. The Unit has provided copy of receipt of application for hazardous waste authorization submitted to UPPCB and application to NOC for ground water abstraction to Central Ground Water Authority.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a three-member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change and National Mission for Clean Ganga for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 27.02.2018 examined the replies and reports of the Unit and made following recommendations (i) The Unit is recommended to start its operation for one month only to assess the performance of ETP after inspection. The final revocation will be considered thereafter by the Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the revocation direction not issued to the unit due to the unit has not installed Web camera; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit has submitted reply on dated 12.12.2018 and informed the unit has installed web camera and connected to the CPCB server and same has verified from IT division, CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the three-member committee in its meeting held on 16.01.2019 examined the reply and recommended the following:

- 1) The unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system including analysis of treated effluent by a reputed government institute within 60 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.
- 2) The unit shall obtain valid consent before resumption of operation.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued for compliance to **M/s. Maharaja Bleaching Works, D-76, Panki, Site-IV, Kanpur, UP:**

- 1) The unit shall submit performance assessment of the effluent treatment system including analysis of treated effluent by a reputed government institute within 60 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.
- 2) The unit shall obtain valid consent to operate before resumption of operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.


