Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi and Haryana State Pollution Control Board inspected **M/s Warmer World LLP, Village-Kurar, Tehsil-Bapoli Road, Panipat, Haryana** (herein after referred as the Unit) on May 30, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and observed the following:

1. The unit was found non-complying w.r.t. treated effluent sample parameters i.e. BOD: 48 mg/l (against norms of 30 mg/l) and COD: 267 mg/l (against norms of 250 mg/l).
2. The unit is not having hazardous waste authorization, no log book is maintained for hazardous waste generation/ disposal.
3. Flow meter is not installed at the bore well and no log book is maintained for ground water abstraction.

WHEREAS, on the basis of above short comings observed during inspection of the unit on May 30, 2018, Central Pollution Control Board issued directions (Show Cause Notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Unit on July 16, 2018; and


WHEREAS, Unit submitted the compliance status vide letter dated August 18, 2018 w.r.t. directions (notice) issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on January 18, 2019 to assess the status of compliance of CPCB directions dated July 16, 2018 and it was observed that Unit has complied with CPCB directions (show cause notice) and complying with Zero Liquid Discharge; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, directions (notice) issued to the Unit (M/s Warmer World LLP, Village-Kurar, Tehsil-Bapoli Road, Panipat, Haryana) vide letter dated July 16, 2018 is hereby revoked.


