Compliance Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which has been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violation of standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s U.P. Dyeing & Printing Works, 68, Nauchandi Ground, Meerut- 250002 (U.P.) (hereafter referred as the unit) is a textile industry; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 23.11.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall remain closed and shall resume manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water Act & Air Act from UPPCB.
2. The unit shall immediately inform to CPCB after resumption of manufacturing operations.
3. The unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (protection) Rules, 1986.
4. The unit shall submit treated effluent quality report from lab recognized under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to CPCB within 30 days of resumption of manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show Cause notice under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 14.11.2018 to the unit for not complying with directions dated 23.11.2017; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies dated 08.12.2018 and 22.01.2019 are examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has submitted air and water consents with validity upto 31.12.2020.
2. The unit has submitted treated effluent analysis report from a laboratory approved under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 which indicates compliance with the norms.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and exercising powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit shall operate its ETP properly so as to achieve compliance of stipulated standards.
2. The unit shall ensure regular connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server.
